Make sure you have enough continuing education credits (CEs) for your certification renewal. Most are on a two-year cycle and must have a total of 30 CEs. If you are still in the four-year cycle, 60 credits are required. Once the four- year cycle is complete, you will then be transferred to the two-year cycle of renewing. ### **2022 AST Conference Highlights**


- Students of Director Karen Chambers and Eastwick College recognized:
